

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Katherine
2 Sue Scott.

4 been born in Coburn on December 12, 1934, to the late Brown and Grace Smith O'Bryan;

6 WHEREAS, Katherine Sue Scott was a military wife and adoring mother. After her
7 husband's retirement from the United States Air Force, the couple returned to South
8 Williamson, Kentucky, and became active members of the First Baptist Church of
9 Williamson; and

10 WHEREAS, an impeccable homemaker, Katherine Sue Scott was an integral part of
11 her children's and grandchildren's lives, and remained active in her church throughout her
12 adult life, volunteering on the Kitchen Committee and the Viola Randolph Mission
13 Society; and

14 WHEREAS, Katherine Sue Scott, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and sister,
15 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 20, 2021,
16 leaving all those whose lives she touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Katherine Sue Scott was preceded in death by her parents; cherished
18 husband, Harold A. Scott Sr.; newborn son, Harold A. Scott Jr.; and three siblings. She is
19 survived by her sons, Mark Scott (Loretta) and Matthew Scott (Lisa); grandchildren,
20 Shawn Scott (Nakia), Malia Scott, Nicholas Scott, and Joshua Scott; great-grandchild,
21 Brooklyn; seven siblings; and a host of other family members, friends, and loved ones
