

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of George
2 Edward "Gee" Monarch III.

3 WHEREAS, George Edward Monarch III was a son of this Commonwealth, having
4 been born in Scottsville on March 19, 1947, to George E. Monarch Jr. and Emma Dee
5 Shrewsbury Monarch; and

6 WHEREAS, George Monarch was a graduate of Breckinridge County High School
7 and the University of Kentucky who received his master's degree from Pakistan Defense
8 College; and

9 WHEREAS, George Monarch was a proud 28-year veteran of the United States
10 Marine Corps who served his country in the Vietnam War, retiring as a Colonel in 1998;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Colonel Monarch was elected to serve as Judge/Executive of
13 Breckinridge County, an office he ably held for three years; and

14 WHEREAS, Colonel Monarch was a member of the Hardinsburg Baptist Church;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, George Edward Monarch III, courageous Marine; trusted public
17 servant; and beloved son, husband, father, and brother, departed this earthly life and
18 entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 27, 2021, leaving all those whose lives
19 he touched in solemn mourning; and

20 WHEREAS, George Monarch is survived by his mother; wife, Kathy Blancett
21 Monarch; son, Dan Monarch (Christy Diebold) and daughter, Mia; and sister, Rebecca
22 Monarch Brown (Dwight);

24 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***

26 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby expresses its most profound sympathy upon the
27 passing of George Edward "Gee" Monarch III, and posthumously thanks him for his

1 service to the United States of America and to the citizens of Breckenridge County.
