

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Margie Montgomery upon her retirement.

2 WHEREAS, this august body gives special commendation to those Kentuckians
3 who give of their own time and talent to fight for the rights of Kentucky's unborn
4 children; and

5 WHEREAS, Margie Montgomery is one such Kentuckian, and this body rightfully
6 honors her on this day upon her retirement; and

7 WHEREAS, for 50 years Margie Montgomery has tirelessly advocated for the most
8 vulnerable citizens of this Commonwealth, the unborn; and

9 WHEREAS, Margie Montgomery founded Right to Life of Louisville in 1970, and
10 was one of three co-founders of Kentucky Right to Life Association, Inc., in 1973; and

11 WHEREAS, Margie Montgomery went on to serve as a lobbyist, newspaper editor,
12 and executive director of Kentucky Right to Life Association, Inc., a position she proudly
13 held since 1974; and

14 WHEREAS, during Margie Montgomery's tenure, she oversaw the Kentucky
15 affiliate of the National Right to Life Committee, and since 1978 represented Kentucky
16 Right to Life on the board for the National Right to Life Committee; and

17 WHEREAS, in 2014, the National Right to Life Committee recognized Margie
18 Montgomery with its Lifetime Achievement Award; and

19 WHEREAS, Margie Montgomery retires as one of the most renowned advocates for
20 the unborn in this Commonwealth, and for her diligence, her tenacity, and her unwavering
21 compassion all in this body congratulate her on this day;

22 NOW, THEREFORE,

23 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
24 ***Kentucky:***

25 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate rightfully commend Margie Montgomery
26 for her five decades of meritorious service to Kentucky Right to Life.
