

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Charles W.
2 Hebel.

3 WHEREAS, Charles Hebel was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born in
4 Louisville to the late Charles W. Sr. and Corrine Hebel; and

5 WHEREAS, Charles Hebel was a proud 1949 graduate of Male High School who
6 went on to graduate from the University of Louisville and the University of Louisville
7 School of Law; and

8 WHEREAS, Charles Hebel was an esteemed attorney who practiced law for more
9 than five decades. The recipient of the prestigious Louis Grauman Award in 2012, he
10 specialized in real estate and tax law, and aside from his law practice lectured at the
11 University of Louisville, the University of Kentucky, the Kentucky Real Estate
12 Commission, and the Louisville Board of Realtors; and

13 WHEREAS, Charles Hebel was a pillar of his community who was the recipient of
14 the Farmington's Anne Bruce Haldeman Award for Preservation of Kentucky Landscapes.
15 He served on several charity boards and non-profits, and was a tireless advocate of
16 historical preservation and land conservation initiatives; and

17 WHEREAS, Charles W. Hebel, renowned Kentucky attorney and cherished
18 husband, father, and grandfather, departed this earthly life on September 30, 2020,
19 leaving all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

20 WHEREAS, Charles Hebel was preceded in death by his parents and his brother,
21 Charles Wilding Hebel. He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Carol; son, Charles W.
22 Hebel IV; daughter, Loren Hebel-Osborne and Kentucky Speaker of the House of
23 Representatives David Osborne; grandchildren, Madeline Ledbetter (Phillip), Elizabeth
24 Hebel, Rachel Hebel Coleman (Gregory), Justin Hebel, and Devyn Hebel; and great-
25 grandchildren, Lyla, Tyler, and Phillip;
