

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Julian
2 Carter Wills.

3 WHEREAS, Julian Carter Wills was a son of this Commonwealth, having been
4 born in Flingsville, Kentucky, on January 27, 1920, the son of the late Herndon and Amy
5 Wills; and

6 WHEREAS, Julian Wills graduated from Crittenden High School in 1939 before
7 enlisting in the United States Army. He attained the rank of Master Sergeant and was one
8 of the last living World War II veterans in Grant County; and

9 WHEREAS, Julian Wills worked for the University of Kentucky Extension Service
10 and served as 6th District Supervisor of Maintenance for the Kentucky Department of
11 Highways. A skilled entrepreneur and business owner, he owned Vicki's Dairy Service
12 and The Hotel Donald in Williamstown; and

13 WHEREAS, Julian Wills served as a Farm Bureau agent for 29 years before his
14 retirement in 1988. After his retirement, he remained a pillar of the Williamstown
15 community and was chosen as Grant County Veteran of the Year in 2014 and Grant
16 Countian of the Year in 2015; and

17 WHEREAS, Julian Wills was a longtime member of the Williamstown United
18 Methodist Church; and

19 WHEREAS, Julian Wills, American patriot and cherished husband, father, and
20 grandfather, departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on August
21 10, 2020, leaving all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

22 WHEREAS, Julian Wills was preceded in death by his wife of 71 years, the former
23 Mary Frances Spegal. He is survived by his daughter, Vicki Lynn Agee and her husband,
24 Mike; granddaughters, Lori Lynn Prince and her husband, Sal, and Holly Lee Vizard and
25 her husband, Matt; and five great-grandchildren;
