

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of James  
2 Clifford "Cliff" Ellerbrook.

3 WHEREAS, James Clifford "Cliff" Ellerbrook was born in Franklin, Indiana, on  
4 January 26, 1946, the cherished son of the late James H. and Margaret Cochran  
5 Ellerbrook; and

6 WHEREAS, a graduate of Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville, Cliff  
7 Ellerbrook was a proud veteran of the United States Navy who served for six years as a  
8 submariner during the Vietnam War; and

9 WHEREAS, Cliff Ellerbrook was a retired employee of Glenn Springs Holding Inc.  
10 An active member of Elkhorn Christian Church in Lexington, Kentucky, he dutifully  
11 served the church as an elder, cabinet chair, and treasurer; and

12 WHEREAS, Cliff Ellerbrook was a pillar of the Lexington community who served  
13 as treasurer of the Fayette County Republican Party and Habitat for Humanity. He was  
14 also treasurer for Lexington SCORE Inc., and had participated in an Honor Flight for  
15 Vietnam veterans in 2019; and

16 WHEREAS, Cliff Ellerbrook, American patriot and cherished husband, father,  
17 grandfather, and brother, departed this earthly life on October 30, 2020, leaving all those  
18 whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

19 WHEREAS, Cliff Ellerbrook is survived by his wife, Barbara "Barb" Ellerbrook;  
20 daughters, Kerrie Hudson and Jennifer Mortland; son, Zachary Ellerbrook and his wife,  
21 Susan; grandchildren, Kainan, Chase, Bailey, Kaymen, Otis, Margie, Pearl, and Ivy;  
22 brother, Neil Ellerbrook and his wife, Karen; and sister, Ann Ellerbrook;
