

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Belfry High School boys' basketball player Bol Kuir.

2 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, during a game against 15th Region rival Lawrence
3 County High School, 7'3" Belfry High School junior Bol Kuir entered his name in the
4 annals of Kentucky high school basketball history; and

5 WHEREAS, Bol Kuir recorded 42 rebounds in the double-overtime win, second in
6 Kentucky history in a single game only behind Russ Milton's 48 rebounds in 1957 and
7 just ahead of legendary "King" Kelly Coleman's 41 in 1956; and

8 WHEREAS, this is the first year Bol Kuir, a native of South Sudan, has played
9 organized basketball. On the season he is averaging 14.8 points, a state-best 14.2
10 rebounds, and 4.2 blocks per game; and

11 WHEREAS, this body honors those athletic achievements that are so extraordinary
12 that they become models by which other student-athletes in this Commonwealth measure
13 themselves; and

14 WHEREAS, in this spirit, the members honor Bol Kuir on this day for his 42
15 rebounds against Lawrence County High School, and grants him very best wishes as his
16 Belfry Pirates enter postseason play;

17 NOW, THEREFORE,

18 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
19 ***Kentucky:***

20 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby honors Belfry High School boys' basketball player
21 Bol Kuir on his 42-rebound performance, and extends best wishes to him as he continues
22 his high school career in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

23 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of Bol Kuir.
