3	WHEREAS, Dr. Tracy Campbell is a proud 1984 graduate of the University of
4	Kentucky. He went on to earn his master's degree and Ph.D. from Duke University, and
5	currently teaches courses in recent United States social and political history at the
6	University of Kentucky; and
7	WHEREAS, in 2010 Dr. Campbell received the Great Teacher Award from the
8	University of Kentucky Alumni Association. He has organized symposia and lectures that
9	connect history with current public policy debates, and in 2018 he was named the E.
10	Vernon Smith and Eloise C. Smith Professor of American History at UK; and
11	WHEREAS, Dr. Campbell is the author of five books, including The Year of Peril,
12	which won the 2020 Book of the Year Award from the World News Group in the
13	Accessible History category, and The Gateway Arch: A Biography, which won the 2014
14	Missouri History Book Award; and
15	WHEREAS, Dr. Campbell's most recent book is The Year of Peril: America in
16	1942, which has just won the prestigious New York Historical Society's Barbara and
17	David Zalaznick Book Prize, awarded each year for the best work of history or biography
18	by an American; and
19	WHEREAS, Jennifer Schuessler, in her review of The Year of Peril for the New
20	York Times, notes that the book "challenges the public memory of the war years as a time
21	of national unity and resolve," a theme which resonates to this day as America strives to
22	collectively define unity and patriotism during the COVID-19 pandemic; and
23	WHEREAS, Dr. Campbell's myriad achievements illustrate what scholarship in the
24	humanities can do for us. He has written extensively about Kentucky in such books as
25	The Politics of Despair: Power and Resistance in the Tobacco Wars, placing our
26	Commonwealth's history in context and creating crucial touchpoints of understanding for
