13 Hikes Point Christian Church; and

14 WHEREAS, Rachel Moter, beloved daughter, mother, and sister, departed this
15 earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on March 10, 2021, leaving all those
16 whose lives she touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Rachel Moter is survived by her parents; cherished daughter, Mira
18 Grace; brother, Cash Moter (Tara); aunt, Cindy Moter; uncle, Jay Lowe (Charlotte); and a
