4 having been born in Ballard County on January 13, 1931, to the late Hurchel Preston and
5 Thelma France Myers; and

6 WHEREAS, Bill Myers was a proud veteran of the United States Navy who served
7 in the Korean War; and

8 WHEREAS, an esteemed educator, Bill Myers graduated from Murray State
9 University and went on to serve as principal of the Lacy School and as a teacher at
10 Crofton School; and

11 WHEREAS, Bill Myers was a devout steward of God who was a member of St.
12 John United Methodist Church; and

13 WHEREAS, Hurchel Franklin "Bill" Myers, American patriot; renowned educator;
14 and beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother, departed this earthly life and
15 entered into the kingdom of Heaven on December 10, 2020, leaving all those whose lives
16 he touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Bill Myers was preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Motella
18 Horton. He is survived by his wife, Patsy K. Myers; daughter, Susanne (Chad) Roberts;
19 siblings, June Kelley, Beverly (Garth) Hart, Linda Newcomb, Joe Thomas (Peggy) Myers,
20 and Patsy (Andrew) Alexander; and granddaughter, Candace Roberts;
