9 where he helped in designing the Kentucky Horse Park and the restoration of the
10 Kentucky Governor's Mansion; and

11 WHEREAS, Clayton Farmer's notable achievements from his architectural practice
12 include the Bengals practice stadium in Georgetown, Kentucky, the Carrick House in
13 Lexington, Kentucky, and various projects at the University of Virginia; and

14 WHEREAS, Clayton Farmer departed this earthly life on December 23, 2020,
15 leaving those who loved and cared for him in solemn mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Clayton Farmer is survived by his wife, Pamela; his children, Honor
17 Baker, Lincoln Farmer, Nicholas Farmer, and Austin Farmer; his grandchildren, Adam
18 Baker, Jacobe Farmer, Alyssa Baker, and Clayton Farmer; and his great grandchildren,
19 Juniper Barker, Kane Farmer, and Wilder Baker;
