3           WHEREAS, Cordis Brown was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born on  
4 March 15, 1927, in Bloomington, Kentucky, to the late Ollie and Rosa Ellen Gullett  
5 Brown; and

6           WHEREAS, Cordis Brown was a proud veteran of the United States Army who  
7 served in the Korean War; and

8           WHEREAS, Cordis Brown was the former owner of Dalton's Restaurant and a  
9 former member of the Powell County Lions Club; and

10           WHEREAS, the Powell County Democratic Party Chairman for more than 20 years,  
11 Cordis Brown was a real estate developer and the owner and breeder of Thoroughbred  
12 horses; and

13           WHEREAS, Cordis Brown, American patriot; pillar of the Stanton community; and  
14 beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother, departed this earthly life on February 6,  
15 2021, leaving all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

16           WHEREAS, Cordis Brown was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Golda Tuttle  
17 Brown; daughter, Karen Stapleton; son, Darvin Sebastian; and three siblings. He is  
18 survived by his children, Delbert Brown, Vicky Lynne Brown, and Leighanna Faye  
19 (Randy McDowell) Brown; sister, Mary Margaret Brown; grandchildren, Holly (Patrick)  
20 Miller, Wes Sebastian, Kelly (Matt Ratcliff) Sebastian, Evan Brown, and Taylor  
21 Stapleton; and great-grandchildren, Makayla, Elleigh, and Ryder;
