Amend printed copy of **SB 1/GA**

On page 2, after line 15, insert the following:

"➔Section 3. (1) As used in this section:

(a) "Red zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate of greater than 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;

(b) "Orange zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than 10 but less than or equal to 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;

(c) "Yellow zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than one but less than or equal to 10 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health; and

(d) "Green zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven day incidence infection rate of less than or equal to one case per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health.

(2) Notwithstanding any other statute or regulation to the contrary, until January 15, 2022, if the Department for Public Health indicates that a county is in a red or orange zone, the Governor may implement a mask mandate on school districts or licensed child care facilities, certified family child care homes, residential child caring facilities, and child placing agencies

(3) Notwithstanding any other statute or regulation to the contrary, until January 15, 2022, if the Department for Public Health indicates that a county is in a yellow or green zone for two consecutive weeks following being in the red zone, then:

(a) The local school board of a school district located in the county can determine to end the mask mandate; and

(b) The local health department can determine to end the mask mandate for licensed child care facilities, certified family child care homes, residential child caring facilities, and child placing agencies."; and

Re-number subsequent sections accordingly; and

On page 4, line 22, delete "5" and insert "6" in lieu thereof; and

On page 9, after line 9, insert the following:

"➔Section 13. Section 3 of this Act shall expire January 15, 2022."; and

Re-number the subsequent section accordingly.
