- (a) "Red zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate of greater than 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;
- (b) "Orange zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than 10 but less than or equal to 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;
- (c) "Yellow zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than one but less than or equal to 10 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health; and
- (d) "Green zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven day incidence infection rate of less than or equal to one case per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health.
- (2) Notwithstanding any other statute or regulation to the contrary, until January 15, 2022, if the Department for Public Health indicates that a county is in a red or orange zone, the Governor may implement a mask mandate on school districts or licensed child care facilities, certified family child care homes, residential child caring facilities, and child placing agencies

- (b) The local health department can determine to end the mask mandate for licensed child care facilities, certified family child care homes, residential child caring facilities, and child placing agencies."; and
