Amend printed copy of **SB 1/SCS 1**

On page 4, after line 2, insert the following:

"➔Section 6. (1) From the effective date of this Act until the end of the 2021-2022 school year, a school district may temporarily assign students to a program of hybrid instruction due to significant community spread of COVID-19 that requires increased social distancing measures in school buildings to enable continued modified in-person instruction.

(2) Notwithstanding the limit of 10 student attendance days in KRS 158.070(9), the school district may request approval from the commissioner of education for additional student attendance days under the district's nontraditional instruction plan necessary to implement a hybrid instruction schedule under this section if the district is offering in-person instruction for at least 80 percent of the instructional time consisting of a minimum of 40 percent in-person instructional time to all students."; and

Re-number subsequent sections accordingly.
