Amend printed copy of **SJR 1**

On page 9, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

"➔Section 8. (1) As used in this section:

- (a) "Red zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate of greater than 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;
- (b) "Orange zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than 10 but less than or equal to 25 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department for Public Health;
- (c) "Yellow zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven-day incident infection rate greater than one but less than or equal to 10 cases per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department of Public Health; and
- (d) "Green zone" means having the status of a SARS-COV-2 seven day incidence infection rate of less than or equal to one case per 100,000 people as determined by the Kentucky Department of Public Health.

(2) When the Department for Public Health indicates that a county is in a red or orange zone, 2021 RS SB 1, 2021 Ky. Acts ch. 6, and 2021 RS SB 5, 2021 Ky. Acts ch. 205, shall be suspended for that county until January 30, 2022.

(3) When the Department for Public Health indicates that a county is in a yellow or green zone

for two consecutive weeks, the Governor may exercise the powers granted under subsection (2) of this section unless the local legislative body finds the following criteria:

- (a) The local board of health recommends that the local legislative body regains control of the emergency; and
- (b) The local legislative body approves the return of control of the emergency;

Nothing in this subsection shall prevent a local legislative body from requesting the Governor from exercising the power granted under subsection (2) of this section for that county.

➔Section 9. Section 8 of this Act shall expire January 30, 2022."; and
Re-number subsequent sections accordingly.
