6		<u>1.</u> The [intentional] infliction of or subjection to extreme physical pain or			
7		injury to a dog or cat, motivated by an intent to cause, increase, or			
8		prolong the pain or suffering of the dog or cat, including but not			
9		limited to:			
10		a. Crushing, burning, drowning, beating, poisoning, electrocuting,			
11		suffocating, hanging, impaling, or skinning alive;			
12		b. Causing physical disfigurement; or			
13		c. Causing the loss of function of a limb or bodily organ; or			
14		2. The infliction of or subjection to extreme physical pain or injury			
15		through the deprivation of:			
16		<u>a. Food;</u>			
17		<u>b. Water;</u>			
18		<u>c. Adequate shelter; or</u>			
19		d. Life-saving medical care;			
20		while restraining the dog or cat with wanton disregard for its pain,			
21		suffering, injury, or death; and			
22		(b) "Restrain" means to keep a dog or cat confined to a finite space such that			
23		the dog or cat cannot seek escape[animal].			
24	(2)	A person is guilty of torture of a dog or cat when he or she, without legal			
25		justification, intentionally tortures a [domestic]dog or cat.			
26	(3)	Torture of a dog or cat is [a Class A misdemeanor for the first offense and]a Class			
27		D felony[for each subsequent offense if the dog or cat suffers physical injury as a

2		injury or death as a result of the torture].			
3	(4)	Eacl	h act of torture of a dog or cat may constitute a separate offense.		
4	<u>(5)</u>	Noth	ning in this section shall apply to the killing or injuring of a dog or cat without		
5		<u>the i</u>	ntent to cause, increase, or prolong the pain or suffering of the dog or cat:		
6		(a)	In accordance with a license to hunt, fish, or trap;		
7		(b)	For humane purposes;		
8		(c)	For veterinary, agricultural, spaying or neutering, or cosmetic purposes;		
9		(d)	For purposes relating to sporting activities including but not limited to training		
10			for organized dog or cat shows, or other animal shows in which a dog or a cat,		
11			or both, participate;		
12		(e)	For bona fide animal research activities, using dogs or cats, of institutions of		
13			higher education; or a business entity registered with the United States		
14			Department of Agriculture under the Animal Welfare Act or subject to other		
15			federal laws governing animal research;		
16		(f)	In defense of self or another person against an aggressive or diseased dog or		
17			cat;		
18		(g)	In defense of a domestic animal against an aggressive or diseased dog or cat;

25	<u>(7)</u> {((6)]	The acts specified in this section shall not constitute cruelty to animals under		
26		KRS	5 525.125 or 525.130.
