Amend printed copy of **HB 136/HCS 1**

On page 36, by deleting lines 1 through 6 in their entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

"(6) (a) Members of the Kentucky Board of Pharmacy, its agents, and its employees shall be immune from suit for discretionary acts in a civil action or criminal action which is based upon any act that is conducted in accordance with this section and administrative regulations promulgated thereunder.

(b) A pharmacist authorized by the board to provide medicinal cannabis consultation services to cardholders or to enter into cannabis consultation agreements with dispensaries shall be immune in any civil action or criminal action as long as the pharmacist acted with ordinary and reasonable care as any pharmacist would in the same or similar circumstances and in accordance with this section and administrative regulations promulgated thereunder."

On page 75, line 16, by deleting "at a minimum"; and

On page 75, line 22, by deleting "Nausea or vomiting" and inserting "Chronic nausea or cyclical vomiting syndrome that has proven resistant to other conventional medical treatments" in lieu thereof.
