

KENTUCKY GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT FORM

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Amend printed copy of **HB 196**

On page 1, delete lines 9 to 19 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(b) "Residential" means situated outdoors on the premises of a detached one (1) family or two (2) family dwelling, or a one (1) family townhouse no more than three (3) stories high; and

"(c) "Swimming pool" means any structure, located in a residential area that is intended for swimming or recreational bathing, and has a surface area of at least two hundred fifty (250) square feet or contains water over twenty-four (24) inches deep, including but not limited to in-ground, aboveground, and on-ground swimming pools, hot tubs, and non-portable spas."; and

On page 1, line 22, by deleting "**high on the outside**" and inserting in lieu thereof "**above grade, measured on the side of the barrier, which faces away from the swimming pool**"; and

On page 2, line 2, by deleting "**one hundred twenty (120) days**" and inserting in lieu thereof "**eighteen (18) months**"; and

On page 2, line 3, by deleting "**at the time**" and inserting in lieu thereof "**within six (6) months**"; and

On page 2, lines 14 to 15, by deleting "**cannot be reached by a child over the top or through any opening or gap**" and inserting in lieu thereof "**is at least forty-five (45) inches above grade**"; and

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On page 2, by deleting lines 16 to 27 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof:

"(5) If a dwelling wall is part of a barrier and contains a door, the door shall be a lockable door.

(6) All fully submerged suction outlets/drain covers shall be certified, installed, and maintained in conformance with ANSI/APSP/ICC-16 American National Standard for Suction Outlet Fitting Assemblies (SOFA) for Use in Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs, and the suction system shall comply with ANSI/APSP/ICC-7 American National Standard for Suction Entrapment Avoidance in Swimming Pools, Wading Pools, Spas, Hot Tubs, And Catch Basins.

(7) A residential swimming pool is exempt from this section if:

(a) It is equipped with a lockable safety cover that complies with American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) F1346 for spas or hot tubs or a powered safety cover that complies with ASTM F1346 for pools for when the spa, hot tub, or pool is not in use or operation; or

(b) It is on five (5) or more contiguous acres of land.

(8) If a barrier of a residential swimming pool that was built before January 1, 2022, is in good condition, the barrier shall be exempt from the height requirement set out in subsection (2)(a) of this section. Once that barrier is in need of repairs or it is replaced, it must conform to the height requirement in subsection (2)(a) of this section."; and

On page 3, by deleting lines 1 and 2; and

On page 4, line 7, by deleting "**fifty (\$50)**" and inserting in lieu thereof "**ten dollars (\$10)**".
