1	AN ACT relating to lung cancer screening and making an appropriation therefor.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 214 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in Sections 1 to 3 of this Act:
6	(a) "Department" means the Department for Public Health in the Cabinet for
7	Health and Family Services; and
8	(b) ''Program'' means the Lung Cancer Screening Program.
9	(2) The Lung Cancer Screening Program is hereby established within the
10	department for the purpose of:
11	(a) Increasing lung cancer screening;
12	(b) Reducing morbidity and mortality from lung cancer; and
13	(c) Reducing the cost of treating lung cancer among citizens of the
14	<u>Commonwealth.</u>
15	(3) The requirements of Sections 1 to 3 of this Act shall be limited to the amount of
16	appropriations to the department for the Lung Cancer Screening Program.
17	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 214 IS CREATED TO
18	READ AS FOLLOWS:
19	(1) (a) There is hereby created a restricted fund to be known as the Kentucky Lung
20	Cancer Screening Program fund.
21	(b) The fund shall be administered by the Finance and Administration Cabinet.
22	(c) The fund shall include moneys:
23	1. Appropriated by the General Assembly for the purpose of the Lung
24	Cancer Screening Program; and
25	2. Distributed by the Transportation Cabinet from extra fees associated
26	with the issuance of any special lung cancer license plates.
27	(2) Moneys in the fund shall be used by the department to administer Sections 1 to 3

2	<u>(3)</u>	Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any moneys remaining in the fund at the close of
3		the fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward into the succeeding
4		fiscal year to be used solely for the purposes established in subsection (2) of this
5		section.
6	<u>(4)</u>	Interest earned on any moneys in the fund shall accrue to the fund.
7	<u>(5)</u>	Moneys in the fund are hereby appropriated solely for the purposes set forth in
8		Sections 1 to 3 of this Act.
9		→SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 214 IS CREATED TO
10	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
11	<u>(1)</u>	A Lung Cancer Screening Advisory Committee is hereby established. The
12		advisory committee shall include:
13		(a) One (1) member of the House of Representatives who shall be appointed by
14		and serve at the pleasure of the Speaker of the House;
15		(b) One (1) member of the Senate who shall be appointed by and serve at the
16		pleasure of the President of the Senate;
17		(c) The deputy commissioner of the Department for Public Health;
18		(d) The commissioner of the Department of Insurance, or his or her designee;
19		(e) The commissioner of the Department for Medicaid Services, or his or her
20		<u>designee;</u>
21		(f) Two (2) at-large members who shall be appointed by the Governor;
22		(g) One (1) member who shall be appointed by the Governor from a list of three
23		(3) names provided by the American Cancer Society;
24		(h) The director of the Kentucky Cancer Program at the University of
25		Kentucky;
26		(i) The director of the Kentucky Cancer Program at the University of

I		(1) The director of the Kentucky Cancer Registry;
2		(k) The director of the American Lung Association of Kentucky;
3		(l) The chair of Kentucky African Americans Against Cancer; and
4		(m) The director of the Kentucky Cancer Consortium.
5	<u>(2)</u>	The chair of the advisory committee shall be elected from the membership of the
6		advisory committee to serve for a two (2) year term. A member of the advisory
7		committee may designate an alternate to attend meetings in his or her place.
8	<u>(3)</u>	The advisory committee may add members of subject matter expertise from other
9		organizations as deemed appropriate.
10	<u>(4)</u>	The advisory committee shall:
11		(a) Review relevant data, clinical guidelines, and best practices for lung cancer
12		screening;
13		(b) Provide recommendations for the overall implementation and conduct of
14		the program with the goal of improving access to high quality lung cancer
15		screening;
16		(c) Establish and provide oversight for a lung cancer screening, public
17		awareness, education, and outreach program to focus on individuals who
18		are eligible for lung cancer screening; and
19		(d) Provide an annual report on implementation and outcomes from the
20		program and recommendations to the Legislative Research Commission,
21		the Interim Joint Committee on Health, Welfare, and Family Services, the
22		Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue, the Governor, the
23		secretary of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, and the
24		commissioner of the Department for Public Health.
25		→ Section 4. Members appointed under subsection (1)(f) and (g) of Section 3 of
26	this	Act shall be appointed for a term of four years, and members shall not serve more
27	than	two terms of four years. Members serving under subsection (1)(c) to (e) and (h) to
