Amend printed copy of HB 221/HCS 1

On page 2, lines 7 through 10, delete all language and insert the following:

- "(2) Enter into an interlocal agreement in accordance with KRS 65.210 to 65.300 for the purposes of implementing and enforcing an ordinance enacted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section. The interlocal agreement shall:
  - (a) Not be entered into without a public comment period of at least thirty (30) days

    from the date the terms of the agreement are made available to the public;
  - (b) Require that the stop arm camera violation is enforced by a law enforcement authority; and
  - (c) Establish clear requirements for record keeping, retention, and deletion, so as to properly secure any recorded images and other records related to a specific stop arm camera violation as private information only accessible to authorized personnel for the purpose of issuing and enforcing stop arm camera violations.
- (3) An ordinance enacted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section shall require

  each school bus equipped with a camera monitoring system to display a warning sign

  notifying the public of the camera monitoring system."; and

On page 3, after line 24, insert:

- "(3) A recorded image produced by a camera monitoring system shall be destroyed:
  - (a) No later than thirty-one (31) days from the date the recorded image is captured if

- the recorded image does not result in a stop arm camera violation issued pursuant to subsection (1) of this section; or
- (b) Upon final disposition of the stop arm camera violation if the recorded image results in a stop arm camera violation issued pursuant to subsection (1) of this section."; and

On page 3, after line 26, insert:

"(1) A recorded image produced by a monitoring system shall be sufficient evidence of a violation of an ordinance adopted pursuant to Section 2 of this Act and shall be admitted without further authentication for the purposes of enforcing the ordinance but shall not be admissible for any other purpose in any other civil or criminal proceeding." and renumber the following subsections accordingly; and

On page 4, line 10, delete "<u>or</u>"; and

On page 4, line 14, delete "." and insert ";"; and

On page 4, after line 14, insert:

- "(e) The violation was necessary to allow the passage of an emergency vehicle;
- (f) The violation was necessary to avoid injuring the person or property of another;
- (g) The violation was incurred while participating in a funeral procession; or
- (h) The violation was necessary in order for the operator to comply with any other general statute or regulation concerning the operation of a motor vehicle.".
