- "(1) Starting with the 2022-2023 school year, a local superintendent shall adopt a curriculum for annual child abuse awareness and prevention instruction for all students in kindergarten through grade twelve (12) that may be integrated into relevant existing curriculum and shall:
 - (a) Include age-appropriate and evidence-based instruction on child physical, sexual, and emotional abuse and neglect awareness and prevention;
 - (b) Include instruction on how to report suspected child abuse and neglect;
 - (c) Be taught by a school counselor, school safety specialist, or other individual with training and expertise in child abuse and neglect awareness and prevention; and
 - (d) Be approved by the department in accordance with subsection (2) of this section.
- (2) A description of curriculum for the child abuse awareness and prevention instruction adopted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section shall be made available for review by parents and guardians on the school Web site, and in print upon request, at least two (2) weeks prior to the instruction.
- (3) The department, with assistance from the Department for Community Based Services and other appropriate agencies, shall:
 - (a) Develop and maintain a list of approved curricula for child abuse awareness and
