On page 10, line 18, delete "and"; and

On page 10, line 20, delete the period and insert "; and" in lieu thereof; and

On page 10, between lines 20 and 21, insert the following:

"(n) Limit participant financial loss due to compulsive gambling by:

- 1. Denying a participant's access to any of that registrant's fantasy contests if the participant has lost in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to that registrant within the previous twenty-four (24) hours, unless the participant has been designated as a highly experienced player; and**
- 2. Maintaining the denial of access under subparagraph 1. of this paragraph for at least an additional twenty-four (24) hours."**; and

On page 13, between lines 1 and 2, insert the following:

"(7) A vendor licensed to offer online poker gaming shall limit player financial loss due to compulsive gambling by:

- (a) Denying a player's access to any of that vendor's online poker games if the player has lost in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to that vendor within the previous twenty-four (24) hours; and**
- (b) Maintaining the denial of access under paragraph (a) of this subsection for at least an additional twenty-four (24) hours."**; and

- "(6) An association with a sports wagering license shall limit a sports wagerer's financial loss due to compulsive gambling by:**
- (a) Denying the wagerer access to any of that association's sports wagering if the wagerer has lost in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to that association due to sports wagering within the previous twenty-four (24) hours; and**
- (b) Maintaining the denial of access under paragraph (a) of this subsection for at least an additional twenty-four (24) hours."**
