19		3. One (1) from the Twenty-third Judicial Circuit to the Thirty-fifth

17		(b) The council shall provide the proposed budget of the unified prosecutorial
18		system of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to the Interim Joint Committee
19		on Appropriations and Revenue each biennium.
20	(5)	Each nonattorney citizen member of the council shall receive twenty-five dollars
21		(\$25) per day for attending each meeting. All council members shall be reimbursed
22		for actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
