10		of twenty (20) years, unless the person[is] employed is at least eighteen (18)
11		<u>years of age</u> [:
12		1. In a bottling house or room of a licensed distiller, winery, brewer, or
13		rectifier;
14		2. In an office of a wholesaler or manufacturer that is maintained in a
15		building separate from the warehouses or factory;
16		3. At premises licensed only with a nonquota retail malt beverage package
17		license, and the person employed to sell malt beverages is at least
18		eighteen (18) years of age] and under the supervision of a person twenty
19		(20) years of age or older [; or
20		4. In any of the following establishments, if the employment is in a
21		capacity that does not involve the sale or serving of alcoholic beverages:
22		a. A restaurant that derives at least fifty percent (50%) of its food and
23		alcoholic beverage sales from the sale of food for consumption on

25		b. Any other establishment with alcoholic beverage sales not

27	(d)	Within two (2) years prior to the date of the person's employment, has had any

2		ordinance relating to the regulation of the manufacture, sale, or transportation
3		of alcoholic beverages revoked for cause.
4	(2)	The provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) of this section shall not
5		apply if the employee's duties do not involve the sale, service, delivery, or traffic in
6		alcoholic beverages at the licensed premises.
7	(3)	A person under the age of twenty (20) years whose employment is authorized
8		under subsection (1) of this section shall not have duties that include bartending.
9	<u>(4)</u>	Violation of this section shall subject both employer and employee to penalties
10		provided in this chapter and shall be cause for revocation of license.
