

1 AN ACT relating to the delivery of education and declaring an emergency.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. School districts which implemented a test-to-stay program under  
4 2021 (1st Extra. Sess.) Ky. Acts ch. 4, sec. 4, shall require no more than five consecutive  
5 calendar days of testing negative in order for a student or staff member to return to the  
6 school or to the district office. Students and staff shall not be required to test on days they  
7 are not required to be at school or work, but if the fifth day falls on a nonschool or  
8 nonwork day, the student or staff member shall test upon returning to school or work.

9 ➔Section 2. Whereas the Commonwealth's students and teachers continue to face  
10 significant challenges due to the COVID-19 public health crisis, an emergency is declared  
11 to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon  
12 its otherwise becoming a law.
