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1 AN ACT relating to fiscal matters providing funding for disaster recovery and

- 2 relief, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 4 → Section 1. (1) There is hereby appropriated Restricted Fund moneys in the
- 5 amount of \$12,000,000 in fiscal year 2021-2022 from the West Kentucky State Aid
- 6 Funding for Emergencies (SAFE) Fund to the Cabinet for Health and Family Services,
- 7 Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities, for
- 8 mental health care in counties impacted by the December 2021 storms and tornadoes.
- 9 (2) The Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual
- 10 Disabilities shall distribute these moneys to the Community Mental Health Centers that
- 11 have been providing mental health services and supports to individuals in the storm-
- impacted counties that are in their designated regions and were named in the Presidential
- Declaration of Emergency issued on December 13, 2021.
- 14 (3) (a) Each of the eight counties named in the Presidential Declaration of
- Emergency shall be allocated \$1,500,000:
- 1. Caldwell County;
- 17 2. Fulton County;
- 18 3. Graves County;
- 19 4. Hopkins County;
- 5. Marshall County;
- 21 6. Muhlenberg County;
- 7. Taylor County; and
- 8. Warren County.
- (b) These moneys shall be used to:
- 25 1. Assist the Community Mental Health Centers in recouping additional costs
- 26 incurred in making services and staff available in the first month following the storms'
- 27 impacts;

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1 2. Provide for hiring additional staff as necessary to address the emerging need

- 2 for additional mental health services to individuals living and working in these affected
- 3 counties; and
- 4 3. Continue providing mental health services in the local schools and consulting
- 5 with school staff in addressing increased mental health demands from students, teachers,
- 6 and staff.
- 7 (4) A Community Mental Health Center shall:
- 8 (a) Reimburse the Commonwealth for the amount of the moneys received from
- 9 the fund if the Community Mental Health Center receives moneys from any other sources
- 10 for the same purpose; and
- 11 (b) Provide information for a report to be submitted by the Cabinet for Health and
- 12 Family Services to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by the
- tenth day of each month, beginning February 10, 2022, and ending July 10, 2024. The
- 14 report shall include:
- 15 1. The name of each Community Mental Health Center receiving moneys from
- 16 the fund;
- 17 2. The dollar amount of moneys received; and
- 18 3. A description of how the moneys were used.
- → Section 2. Whereas support and relief efforts are imperative for the
- 20 Commonwealth to recover from the considerable damage caused by deadly storms and
- 21 tornadoes, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage
- and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
