AN ACT relating to military leave.

2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→ Section 1. KRS 61.394 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) All officers and employees of this state, or of any department or agency thereof who
 5 are members of the National Guard or of any reserve component of the Armed
 6 Forces of the United States, or of the reserve corps of the United States Public
 7 Health Service, shall be entitled to leave of absence from their respective duties,
 8 without loss of time, pay, regular leave, impairment of efficiency rating, or of any
 9 other rights or benefits to which they are entitled, while:
- 10(a)In the performance of duty or training in the service of a state or of the United11States under competent orders as specified in this section;
- 12(b) Physically disabled as a result of an injury, illness, or disease incurred or13aggravated in the line of duty while performing active-duty or inactive-duty
- 14 *training; or*
- 15 (c) Entitled to incapacitation pay pursuant to 37 U.S.C. sec. 204.
- *Leave pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (c) of this subsection shall not exceed six* (6) months unless approved by the employee's appointing authority.
- In any one (1) federal fiscal year, officers or employees, while on military leave,
 shall, *upon request*, be paid their salaries or compensations for a period or periods
 not exceeding twenty-one (21) calendar days. Any unused military leave in a federal
 fiscal year shall be carried over to the next year. Any unused military leave shall
 expire two (2) years after it has accrued.
