- 3 → Section 1. KRS 248.353 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) Compliance with the provisions of KRS 248.350 shall be monitored by the
- 5 department with enforcement assistance provided by the Special Prosecutions Unit
- of the Office of the Attorney General.
- 7 (2) The Attorney General at the request of the commissioner:
- 8 (a) May make such public or private investigations within or outside of this state
- 9 as he <u>or she</u> deems necessary to determine if any person has violated or is
- about to violate KRS 248.350 or any administrative regulation or order
- thereunder, or to aid in the enforcement of KRS 248.350 or in the prescribing
- of administrative regulations and forms thereunder;
- 13 (b) May require or permit any person to file a statement in writing, under oath or
- otherwise as the Attorney General may determine, as to all the facts and
- circumstances concerning the matter to be investigated; and
- 16 (c) May publish information concerning any violation of KRS 248.350 or any
- administrative regulation or order thereunder.
- 18 (3) For the purpose of any investigation or proceeding under KRS 248.350, the
- 19 Attorney General or any officer designated by him *or her* may administer oaths and
- affirmations, subpoena witnesses, compel their attendance, take evidence, and
- 21 require production of any books, papers, correspondence, memoranda, agreements,
- or other documents or records which the Attorney General deems relevant or
- 23 material to the inquiry.
- 24 (4) In case of contumacy by, or refusal to obey a subpoena issued to, any person, any
- court of competent jurisdiction, upon application by the Attorney General, may
- 26 issue to that person an order requiring him *or her* to appear before the Attorney
- 27 General, or the officer designated by him <u>or her</u>, there to produce documentary

1	evidence if so ordered or to give evidence touching the matter under investigation or
2	in question; and any failure to obey the order of the court may be punished by the
3	court as a contempt of court.
4	(5) No person is excused from attending and testifying or from producing any
5	document or record before the Attorney General, or in obedience to the subpoena of the
6	Attorney General or any officer designated by him or her, or in any proceeding instituted
7	by the Attorney General, on the ground that the testimony or evidence (documentary or
8	otherwise) required of him <u>or her</u> may tend to incriminate him <u>or her</u> or subject him <u>or</u>
9	<u>her</u> to a penalty or forfeiture; but no individual may be prosecuted or subjected to any
10	penalty or forfeiture for or on account of any transaction, matter, or thing concerning
11	which he <u>or her</u> is compelled, after claiming his <u>or her</u> privilege against self-
12	incrimination, to testify or produce evidence (documentary or otherwise), except that the
13	individual so testifying shall not be exempt from prosecution and punishment for perjury
14	committed in so testifying.
