2	Be it	enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	No later than July 1 of each year, the president or chief executive officer of each
6		state institution or independent institution that is licensed or overseen by the
7		Council on Postsecondary Education, and the chair of the governing board of
8		each institution, shall jointly execute a signed, sworn statement attesting to
9		whether the institution:
10		(a) In sound financial standing with a stable financial base to support the
11		mission of the institution and the scope of its programs and services;
12		(b) Underwent an institutional audit for the most recent fiscal year prepared by
13		an independent certified public accountant or appropriate government
14		auditing agency employing the appropriate audit guide; and
15		(c) Has an annual budget that is preceded by sound planning, subject to sound
16		fiscal procedures, and approved by the president of the institution and the
17		chair of the governing board.
18	<u>(2)</u>	Each institution shall provide the sworn statement required by subsection (1) of
19		this section to the president of the Council on Postsecondary Education, the
20		chairs of the Budget Review Subcommittee on Education of the Interim Joint
21		Committee on Appropriations and Revenue, and the co-chairs of the Interim
22		Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue.
23	<u>(3)</u>	If an institution fails to provide a statement as required by subsection (2) of this
24		section, the Council on Postsecondary Education shall have the authority to
25		conduct an investigation and request any financial documentation necessary to
26		inform a report on the financial data required by subsection (1) of this section.
27		The Council shall report its findings to the chairs of the Budget Review
