

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Frank Wagner Memorial Highway in
2 Powell County.

3 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was born on June 18, 1945, to Frank and Elizabeth
4 Wagner; and

5 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was one of the approximately 2.7 million American
6 men and women who served in Vietnam; and

7 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner proudly served this country as a plane load specialist
8 with the United States Air Force; and

9 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was injured while flying supplies to Vietnam when the
10 plane he was flying in hit turbulence. This caused him a closed brain injury that resulted
11 in convulsions, which led him being medically discharged from the Air Force. It was a
12 condition that would plague him the rest of his life; and

13 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was a carpenter by trade and highly respected in his
14 field; and

15 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was a loving and caring being who was always ready to
16 lend a hand to anyone in need. He was a God-fearing man who attended Landmark
17 Baptist Church; and

18 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner was a moral man who behaved in a way that was
19 believed by most people to be good and right. He was seen as a true inspiration to a lot of
20 people who knew him; and

21 WHEREAS, Frank Wagner departed these earthly bounds on November 24, 2018.
22 He was survived by his wife Barbara; daughters Lora Wagner, Sherry Hawkins, and
23 Diana Kimmel; and son Matthew Wagner; and

24 WHEREAS, this highway designation will serve as a constant reminder of the life
25 and memory of Frank Wagner;

26 NOW, THEREFORE,

27 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

1 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 3352 in
2 Powell County as the "Frank Wagner Memorial Highway," and shall, within 30 days of
3 the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.
