A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor of Kentucky
 Educational Television.

WHEREAS, Kentucky Educational Television, established by the Kentucky General Assembly in 1962, remains committed to its founding ideals of harnessing the power of television and technology to ensure that every Kentuckian, no matter their location or circumstance, has access to quality educational programs and resources; and

WHEREAS, KET is Kentucky's only statewide media network, connecting all
regions of the Commonwealth and serving as one of the most frequently used and visible
state agencies; and

WHEREAS, KET is used by more than one million Kentuckians each week and in every public school in the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, generations of parents and caregivers have relied on trusted
educational programs including *Sesame Street* and *Mister Rogers' Neighborhood* to help
prepare children for school and life; and

WHEREAS, KET's multimedia classroom service, PBS LearningMedia, provides
engaging educational content for teachers and students, including KET-produced
resources that are some of the most utilized in the country; and

WHEREAS, as the largest nonprofit GED education publisher in the country, KET
supports adult learners with its FastForward learning system and Workplace Essential
Skills, which support and promote career readiness and workforce development; and

WHEREAS, KET's statewide broadcast network provides critical links in the
 Commonwealth's emergency communications network, supporting the National Weather
 Service, FBI, Kentucky State Police, Kentucky Emergency Warning System, and others;
 and

WHEREAS, almost 45 years ago, KET began its comprehensive, live coverage of the Kentucky General Assembly, which now includes its Legislative Coverage App and online streaming; and

10	Commonwealth's most trusted educational and community resources; and

13	Commonwealth by educating, informing, and inspiring Kentuckians;
