1	A RESOLUTION urging the United States House of Representatives to pass, and
2	for President Joe Biden to sign, the Sunshine Protection Act of 2021.
3	WHEREAS, according to the United States Department of Transportation, daylight
4	saving time saves energy and lives and reduces traffic injuries and crime; and
5	WHEREAS, making daylight saving time permanent would continue these benefits
6	throughout the year; and
7	WHEREAS, since 2015, about 30 states have introduced legislation to end the
8	twice-yearly changing of clocks; and
9	WHEREAS, the United States Senate adopted the Sunshine Protection Act of 2021
10	unanimously by voice vote on March 15, sending the bill to the United States House of
11	Representatives; and
12	WHEREAS, the House Energy and Commerce committee held a hearing on the
13	issue last week, where Representative Frank Pallone, the committee's chairman, said,
14	"The loss of that one hour of sleep seems to impact us for days afterwards. It also can
15	cause havoc on the sleeping patterns of our kids and our pets."; and
16	WHEREAS, Representative Pallone cited a 2019 poll that found 71% of Americans
17	prefer to no longer switch their clocks twice a year; and
18	WHEREAS, in one 2017 study from Denmark, scientists analyzed a psychiatric
19	database of more than 185,000 people from 1995 to 2012, finding that the fall transition
20	to standard time was associated with an 11 percent increase in depressive episodes, an
21	effect that took 10 weeks to dissipate, and that the spring switch had no similar effect;
22	and
23	WHEREAS, permanent daylight saving time would benefit Kentuckians by
24	providing more afternoon daylight hours throughout the year, allowing for more time for
25	recreation, spending time with family and friends, and supporting local businesses;
26	NOW, THEREFORE,

2 → Section 1. The House of Representatives hereby urges the United States House
3 of Representatives to pass the Sunshine Protection Act of 2021 to permanently adopt
4 daylight saving time.
