A RESOLUTION commemorating the 40th anniversary of Mothers Against Drunk Driving.

WHEREAS, founded in 1980, Mothers Against Drunk Driving has passionately advocated for the end of drunk driving and tirelessly supported victims of violent crimes associated with drunk driving; and

WHEREAS, the United States sees more than 10,000 deaths a year due to drunk and impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 300,000 incidents a day in America of drinking and driving; and

WHEREAS, in Kentucky, 20 percent of all highway fatalities are caused by drunk drivers; and

WHEREAS, since the founding of Mothers Against Drunk Driving Kentucky, highway fatalities due to drunk driving in the Commonwealth have dropped from almost 500 per year to less than 200; and

WHEREAS, Mothers Against Drunk Driving Kentucky has been a consistent, invaluable voice in this Commonwealth's stand against impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, Mothers Against Drunk Driving Kentucky was an instrumental part of the ignition interlock bill, which became law on July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives on this day commend Mothers Against Drunk Driving upon its 40th anniversary, and in so doing recognize the Kentucky chapter of Mothers Against Drunk Driving for all it continues to do on behalf of the victims of drunk driving in this Commonwealth;
