

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing February 15, 2022, as Angelman Syndrome  
2 Awareness Day.

3 WHEREAS, Angelman syndrome is a rare, neurogenetic disorder that affects  
4 chromosome 15, resulting in intellectual and developmental delay; and

5 WHEREAS, about 1 in 20,000 people in the United States are affected by  
6 Angelman syndrome; and

7 WHEREAS, Angelman syndrome is a complex genetic disorder that primarily  
8 affects the nervous system; and

9 WHEREAS, February is International Rare Disease Month; and

10 WHEREAS, the purpose of Angelman Syndrome Awareness Day is to raise  
11 awareness of this condition, mobilize people to action, encourage fundraising, promote  
12 research and educational resources, and remember those affected with Angelman  
13 syndrome; and

14 WHEREAS, with early identification and treatment, medical, sleep, seizure, and  
15 developmental issues associated with Angelman syndrome may be managed; and

16 WHEREAS, the Angelman Syndrome Foundation provides advocacy, education,  
17 support, and access to resources for parents and researchers around the world;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 ***Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the***  
20 ***Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

21 ➔Section 1. The House of Representatives hereby recognizes February 15, 2022,  
22 as Angelman Syndrome Awareness Day.
