

1 AN ACT relating to adult-size changing tables.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 198B.010 TO 198B.290 IS  
4 CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) As used in this section, "public building, structure, or facility" means any of the*  
6 *following with the capacity to serve one thousand five hundred (1,500) or more*  
7 *people per day:*

8 *(a) A building, structure, or facility owned by the Commonwealth;*

9 *(b) A building, structure, or facility used for exhibition or entertainment,*  
10 *including but not limited to a movie theater, performance theater, concert*  
11 *hall, convention center, store that is larger than forty thousand (40,000)*  
12 *square feet, or shopping mall;*

13 *(c) A building, structure, or facility used for public display or collection,*  
14 *including but not limited to a museum, library, or gallery;*

15 *(d) A place of recreation, including but not limited to a park, zoo, or*  
16 *amusement park; or*

17 *(e) Any of the following:*

18 *1. An airport;*

19 *2. A bus station;*

20 *3. An interstate rest area;*

21 *4. A place of education;*

22 *5. A hospital; or*

23 *6. A rehabilitation facility.*

24 *(2) The department shall promulgate administrative regulations pursuant to KRS*  
25 *Chapter 13A to require:*

26 *(a) A public building, structure, or facility constructed on or after January 1,*  
27 *2024, or renovated on or after January 1, 2026, for renovations having an*

1           estimated cost of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more, to contain and  
2           provide access to at least one (1) powered, height-adjustable, adult-size  
3           changing table in a single occupancy restroom that is universal to gender  
4           and available to the public; and

5           (b) The location of the restroom containing the adult-size changing table be  
6           conspicuously displayed at the entrance of the building, structure, or  
7           facility, where it is located. If the building, structure, or facility has a  
8           central directory, the location shall be indicated in that directory.

9           (3) The administrative regulations promulgated pursuant to subsection (2) of this  
10           section:

11           (a) May exempt historical buildings, structures, and facilities whose historical  
12           significance would be threatened or destroyed if required to comply; and

13           (b) Shall be incorporated into the Kentucky Building Code.
