When one (1) extra day is 4 mentioned in [paragraphs (a), (i) and (i) of ]subsection (1)(a), (i), and (k) of this 5 *section*, the Governor shall designate the extra day. 6 Any state employee who is the spouse of a member of the United States Armed (3) 7 Forces, including a member of a state National Guard or a Reserve component on 8 federal active duty, shall receive, at the discretion of the state employee, one (1) day 9 off, with pay, from work when the member is deployed and one (1) day off, with 10 pay, from work when the member returns from deployment. 11 (4) The holidays set out in this section are in addition to vacation leave and other

12 benefits of state employees.
