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1	AN ACT relating to Medicaid coverage for sickle cell disease.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 205 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) The cabinet shall conduct an annual review of all medications, services, and
6	forms of treatment for enrollees with a diagnosis of sickle cell disease that are
7	eligible for coverage under the Kentucky medical assistance program. The
8	purpose of the annual review shall be to determine if the available covered
9	medications, services, and treatments are adequate to meet the need of enrollees
10	with a diagnosis of sickle cell disease and if Department for Medicaid Services
11	should seek to expand coverage to include additional medications, services, and
12	treatments.
13	(2) When conducting the annual review required by this section, the cabinet shall
14	solicit and consider input from the general public with specific emphasis on
15	obtaining input from individuals or groups with knowledge and experience in the
16	area of sickle cell disease treatment.
17	(3) (a) No later than January 15, 2023, and no later than January 15 each year
18	thereafter, the cabinet shall submit a report to the Legislative Research
19	Commission for distribution to the appropriate subject matter committees.
20	The report required by this subsection shall detail the cabinet's findings
21	from the annual review required by this section and any recommendations
22	based on those findings.
23	(b) The cabinet shall make the report required by paragraph (a) of this
24	subsection available on its Web site in a manner that is accessible by the
25	general public.
26	(4) This section may be cited as Terrence's Law.
