1	AN ACT relating to public utilities.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 278 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	As used in Sections 1 and 2 of this Act:
6	(1) "Automatic fuel adjustment clause" means a direct, separate charge listed on the
7	customer bill, calculated and expressed in price per kilowatt-hour, that reflects
8	the change in the utility's fuel or purchase power costs to serve the customer from
9	one (1) billing period to the next billing period; and
10	(2) "Utility" has the same meaning as in KRS 278.010(3)(a) and (b) and that owns
11	and operates an electric generation and transmission facility in the
12	<u>Commonwealth.</u>
13	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 278 IS CREATED TO
14	READ AS FOLLOWS:
15	(1) Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act, the commission shall open
16	an administrative case to examine the use of the fuel adjustment clause by
17	regulated electric and natural gas utilities. The examination will determine
18	whether:
19	(a) Automatically passing on fuel costs to utility customers causes customer
20	bills to exceed the average household's budget constraint; and
21	(b) The administrative regulation that governs the fuel adjustment clause can
22	be modified to create a ceiling and floor that will smooth the volatility in
23	utility bills due to the pass-through of fuel costs or insulate the customer's
24	household from utility bills that greatly exceed the household budget
25	<u>constraint.</u>
26	(2) The commission shall report its findings and recommendations regarding the
27	impact and use of the fuel adjustment clause by electric and natural gas utilities,
