

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Brooke Forde for winning a silver medal at the 2020
2 Olympics.

3 WHEREAS, Brooke Forde is a proud native of Louisville, Kentucky; and

4 WHEREAS, the daughter of renowned sportswriter Pat Forde and collegiate
5 swimmer Tricia Forde, Brooke Forde learned how to swim competitively at Louisville's
6 historic Lakeside Swim Club; and

7 WHEREAS, Brooke Forde went on to graduate from Sacred Heart High School
8 before taking her talents to Stanford University, where she has won four NCAA
9 individual titles and was named the Pac-12 scholar-athlete of the year in women's
10 swimming; and

11 WHEREAS, at the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo, Brooke Forde swam the anchor
12 leg of the women's 800-meter freestyle, winning a silver medal and marking a historic
13 moment in the deep history of this Commonwealth's athletic tradition; and

14 WHEREAS, for her extraordinary talent as a swimmer, for her many contributions
15 to the sport of college swimming as a student-athlete at Stanford, and for being one of the
16 city of Louisville's shining jewels in and out of the pool, this body honors Brooke Forde
17 on this day for her silver medal-winning performance at the 2020 Olympics;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*
20 *Kentucky:*

21 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate, individually and collectively, hereby
22 honor Brooke Forde for winning a silver medal at the 2020 Olympics.

23 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of Brooke
24 Forde.
