

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Landon
2 Lavelle Trent Hayes.

3 WHEREAS, this august body pauses in solemn reverence on this day to
4 acknowledge the life of Landon Lavelle Trent Hayes; and

5 WHEREAS, Landon was a well-known young man with an outstanding personality,
6 and described by his friends as selfless and loving; and

7 WHEREAS, Landon was so well-known and loved that many considered him a
8 legend of the East End neighborhood, and he was a young man who didn't hesitate to
9 speak his mind and tell it like it is; and

10 WHEREAS, Landon was a student of the Fayette County Public School System,
11 and attended Ashland Elementary School; and

12 WHEREAS, Landon had a passion for football, playing as number 10 for the
13 Lexington Ravens and sporting the nickname "Mr. 2.0"; and

14 WHEREAS, Landon is survived by his parents, Louis W. Hayes Jr. and Ariane
15 Hayes; his siblings, Ariell, Ayanna, Arianna, and Louis Hayes III; his grandparents, his
16 great-grandmother; and a host of nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends;

18 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
19 ***Kentucky:***

20 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate, individually and collectively, hereby
21 express their deepest sympathy upon the passing of Landon Lavelle Trent Hayes, and
22 posthumously honor his life and the impact his life has left on others.
