A RESOLUTION honoring the cross-country and track teams at Liberty Elementary School.

WHEREAS, in 2016, Liberty Elementary School in Lexington, Kentucky, had a
need to begin a cross-country and track program. During the inaugural year, Lindsey
Roberts became head coach of the boys and girls teams and began to lay the foundation
for a championship cross-country and track team; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, Liberty Elementary School registered its first boys and girls
cross-country teams. In 2017, the school began its first boys and girls track teams; and

9 WHEREAS, since the teams' inceptions, participation and rankings have grown 10 statewide with the Kentucky Track and Cross-Country Coaches Association (KTCCCA). 11 At the conclusion of the 2020 cross-country season during the KTCCCA state 12 championship meet, the girls' team was named state champions and the boys' team placed 13 third in the 4th grade and under divisions. During the 2021 cross-country season, the 14 boys' team was undefeated going into the 2021 KTCCCA state championship meet. Both 15 the boys' and girls' teams were named state champions of the 4th grade and under 16 division. To commemorate the 2021 cross-country season, six members of the team were 17 named to the 4th grade and under all-state cross-country team: Emma Clark, Maggie 18 Henderson, Evie Wiles, Brooklynn Helton, Tripp Hudspeth, and Kingston Hudspeth. 19 Additionally, Kingston Hudspeth was named the 2021 individual state champion; and

20 WHEREAS, since 2017, the boys' and girls' track teams have excelled at the same 21 pace as the cross-country teams. On May 18, 2019, at the KTCCCA Elementary State 22 Championship, the girls' track team was named overall state champions and the boys' 23 track team placed 3rd overall. The 2020 KTCCCA Elementary State Championship was 24 cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic; however, the boys' and girls' track teams 25 managed to adapt their practice habits and continued to prepare for the 2021 track season. 26 The 81 students, specializing in numerous track and field events, participated in the May 27 29, 2021, KTCCCA Elementary State Championship, and the boys' and girls' track teams

1 were both named overall state champions; and

WHEREAS, with the support of assistant coaches Leah Park, Kevin Kyde, Eric Harshman, and Rick Ingram, Coach Roberts is prepared to take the boys' and girl's track teams to defend the state championship titles at the KTCCCA Elementary State Championship on May 21, 2022. Coach Roberts and his coaching team look forward to more championship years with future cross-country and track seasons;
