3	WHEREAS, since 1976, the Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation has presented the
4	Kentucky Miss Basketball Award to the outstanding female graduating high school
5	basketball player in the Commonwealth; and
6	WHEREAS, Amiya Jenkins of Anderson County High School has been named the
7	Kentucky's Miss Basketball for 2022; and
8	WHEREAS, during the 2021-22 season, Amiya Jenkins, a 5'10" senior guard,
9	averaged 20.6 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.1 steals, and 2.9 assists per game for the Lady
10	Bearcats; and
11	WHEREAS, Amiya Jenkins was the undisputed leader and lynchpin of a talented
12	Anderson County squad which finished the 2022 season with 30 wins and only 5 losses,
13	losing to eventual state champion Sacred Heart in the first round of the Sweet Sixteen;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, Amiya Jenkins finished her career with 2,212 points and 739
16	rebounds, and led the Lady Bearcats to three consecutive Eighth Region titles, with her
17	team and the sport falling victim to the COVID-19 cancellation in 2020, and losing to the
18	eventual state champion the past two years; and
19	WHEREAS, Lady Bearcats coach Clay Birdwhistell called Amiya Jenkins the
20	state's best defender, stating, "She's so versatile; we could put her on one through five
21	and be OK. If we need her to go lock somebody down and take somebody out, she can do
22	that. And if we need to put her on top of a zone and be disruptive and cause turnovers,
23	she can do that, too. There aren't many people who carry the scoring load she carries who
24	can be so impactful on the defensive end."; and
25	WHEREAS, Amiya Jenkins, who has signed to continue her academic and athletic
26	career at the University of Kentucky, is the first player from the Eighth Region to be
27	named Miss Baskethall since 1992: and
