

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing the former Cayce High School of Fulton County.

2 WHEREAS, a community school can provide a multitude of benefits to students,
3 faculty, and neighborhoods; and

4 WHEREAS, a community school's focus on academics, health, social skills, and
5 community development and engagement leads to improved student learning, stronger
6 families, and healthier communities; and

7 WHEREAS, the community school known as Cayce High School in Fulton County,
8 Kentucky, provided all of those things to its students beginning in 1914; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1936 a new Cayce High School building was built in cooperation
10 with the Works Progress Administration; and

11 WHEREAS, Cayce High School would serve students from the community in
12 grades nine through twelve for the next twenty years, graduating the last seniors in 1957;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, students in grades one through eight would continue their education
15 within the walls of the Cayce High School building until 1986; and

16 WHEREAS, for more than seven decades, Cayce High School provided a location
17 for students, families, and the community to come together and support learning;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
20 ***Kentucky:***

22 Cayce High School and commend the school for the dedication, service, and sense of
23 community it provided to the families of Cayce, Kentucky.
