- 8 creating a system for prolonged relocation out of Cuba to the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Kentucky has provided a safe and democratic environment that
- 10 empowers the Cuban community through freedoms of expression, education, and
- 11 economic opportunity; and
- WHEREAS, On July 11, 2021, protestors in Cuba, and in Kentucky, publicly spoke
- out in protest of the intolerable conditions imposed on the people of Cuba and the unjust
- detainment of over 150 political prisoners; and
- WHEREAS, the Kentucky Senate stands for equality for all, and against any and all
- 16 restrictions on free speech and related freedoms;

- 18 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
- 19 Kentucky:
- 20 Section 1. The Senate hereby expresses the condemnation of any unjust
- 21 practices and violations of human rights against the people of Cuba, and their families,
- domestic and abroad.
