8 WHEREAS, Chris Pace was a member of First Calvary Christian Church, and a
9 lifelong Christian; and

10 WHEREAS, he received his Juris Doctor from Chase School of Law; and

11 WHEREAS, Chris Pace was the proud father of sons Jack and Roman, as well as
12 daughter Maria; and

13 WHEREAS, he was a proud and passionate member of the Clark County
14 community, serving on a number of boards for those issues he held most dear; and

15 WHEREAS, Chris Pace began his position of Judge/Executive after defeating an
16 incumbent in 2018; and

17 WHEREAS, this body holds in high esteem those who choose a life of public
18 service and in this spirit does so honor Judge/Executive Chris Pace for his service to the
19 citizens of Clark County; and
