

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Nancy
2 Clouse Mitchell.

3 WHEREAS, Nancy Clouse Mitchell was born in Corbin, Kentucky, on February 25,
4 1948, the beloved daughter of the late Audrey and Hazel Clouse; and

5 WHEREAS, Nancy Clouse Mitchell attended Midway College and graduated
6 summa cum laude from Union College with degrees in accounting and business
7 administration. With those degrees, she established Mitchell Tax and Accounting in 1976
8 in her prized hometown of Corbin. Nancy Clouse Mitchell was devoted to her firm and
9 worked diligently until her retirement in 2013; and

10 WHEREAS, Nancy Clouse Mitchell was equally dedicated to her hometown and
11 was a zealous champion for women in business and leadership throughout southern
12 Kentucky. She was one of the first women voted into the local Kiwanis Club and the first
13 woman to be elected to the Corbin City Commission, where she served two terms as Vice
14 Mayor. Nancy Clouse Mitchell served eight years as a Trustee at Union College, eight
15 years on the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals, and 12 years on the board of directors for
16 the KCEOC Community Action Partnership; and

17 WHEREAS, Nancy Clouse Mitchell shared a love of politics with her husband, and
18 she served as Vice President of the Kentucky Federation of Republican Women, Vice
19 Chair of the Republican Party of Knox County, and Treasurer of Kentucky's Fifth
20 Congressional District Lincoln Club. To acknowledge Nancy Clouse Mitchell's political
21 service, she and her husband were jointly inducted into the Fifth District Lincoln Club
22 Hall of Fame; and

23 WHEREAS, Nancy Clouse Mitchell is survived by her husband of 54 years, Bob
24 Mitchell; children, Stephanie Mitchell Alsip and Jenny Barnett (Jeff); grandchildren, Tori
25 Ellison, Taelor Ellison Pierce (Elisha), Trenton Alsip, and Ethan Alsip; and a host of
26 other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss her compassionate
27 heart and smile that lit up every room;

2 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*
3 *Kentucky:*
