

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Steve Alley upon his January 1, 2022, retirement.

2 WHEREAS, Steve Alley retired January 1, 2022, as Vice President of Sales for
3 Ingram Barge Company; and

4 WHEREAS, Ingram Barge is the largest inland river transportation company in the
5 industry, managing 4000 barges and 150 tow boats, operating a huge division in Paducah,
6 Kentucky; and

7 WHEREAS, Steve Alley is a past Chairman of and serves on the Tennessee-
8 Tombigbee Waterway Development Council, advising the Tennessee-Tombigbee
9 Waterway Development Authority, which includes the Governors of Kentucky,
10 Tennessee, Alabama, and Mississippi; and

11 WHEREAS, Steve Alley continues to serve as an appointee on the Kentucky
12 Governor's seven-member Waterway Transportation Advisory Board, having done so
13 since the board's creation in 2010; and

14 WHEREAS, Steve Alley has worked over the years with Kentucky economic
15 development teams and Kentucky port directors to expand and draw industry to our great
16 Commonwealth, one such project being the Nucor Steel Brandenburg facility which
17 promises to create 400 full-time Kentucky-resident jobs; and

18 WHEREAS, Steve Alley is an ordained Catholic Deacon at his home Parish of St.
19 Timothy in Union, Kentucky; and

20 WHEREAS, Steve Alley and his wife, Michelle, along with their children and
21 grandchildren, have happily called Kentucky home since 1990;
