14	not this ship, the public's most accessible commissioned vessel, America's heritage. I can

16	of our ship of state, recognizing that for them too, there is no limit to what they can

23	Electrical Officer and Navigator, and onboard the U.S.S. San Jacinto as Weapons Officer

26	Section Head, and Assistant Board Screener at Navy Personnel Command in Millington,
