

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and memory of Ronald E. "Ron"  
2 Crimm.

3 WHEREAS, Ron Crimm was a native of West Lawn, Pennsylvania. In 1957, he  
4 earned a business degree from Shippensburg University; and

5 WHEREAS, Ron Crimm was the owner of Crimm Insurance, a manager of Paul  
6 Revere Companies, district manager with Connecticut General Life, and a teacher in the  
7 Rose Tree Union School District; and

8 WHEREAS, Ron Crimm was an honorable veteran of the United States Army,  
9 where he served with great valor as a Field Marshall; and

10 WHEREAS, Ron Crimm was a highly respected community member within  
11 Louisville, Kentucky. He was a proud Republican who served as Chair of the Jefferson  
12 County Republican Party from 1993 to 1996; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1996, Ron Crimm was elected to serve in the Kentucky House of  
14 Representatives for the 33rd District, representing esteemed citizens of Louisville. For the  
15 next two decades, Representative Crimm served with warmth, integrity, and vision as a  
16 committee member of Banking and Insurance; Licensing and Occupations; Local  
17 Government; Veterans, Military Affairs, and Public Protection; Appropriations and  
18 Revenue; and Capital Planning Advisory Board; and

19 WHEREAS, Ron Crimm died on August 25, 2022, leaving behind a host of family  
20 members, friends, and loved ones who will mourn his passing for years to come;
